

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATHLETICS CARNIVAL

WEDNESDAY JUNE 13, 2018

SYLVANIA WATERS ATHLETICS TRACK

- If you are participating in the 1500m or 17+ years javelin you must be at the track by 8.15am for an 8.30am start. After the race has been completed you must have your name marked off by your Pastoral Care teacher.
- Roll Call will be held between 9.00am and 9.20am. Each Pastoral Care teacher will be positioned in a line, on the inside of the running track, with a folder that displays their PC class. You must make your way to that teacher and have your name marked off. If for some reason you arrive late you must find your Year Coordinator and have your name marked off. The final roll call for the day will take place inside the main running track in Year group areas.
- Students in Year 11 are to wear clothing in their house colour and Year 12, after liaising with the Year Coordinator, wear their approved themed colours.
- Students in Years 7-10 must wear their sports uniform to and from the track. You may bring a coloured shirt appropriate to your House colour to change into for the duration of the Carnival. You will need to change back before the end of the day.
- It is very important you report to the right areas when your event is called. If you are required in more than one place the track events take priority. You can always return to the field event and complete it because the teacher will have your name. Make sure you give the field event teacher your name first.
- All running events are TIMED FINALS. That is you must run as fast as you can against the clock. Each heat is random in terms of strength or weakness of competitors.
- Listen to announcements at all times and check with your House Captains.
- All House Cheers will be performed at 9:00am, at the completion of the 1500m, in front of the Grand Stand. Everyone must stay seated in their House area whilst the Cheers are being held.
- There will be novelty events for Years 7-12 (if weather permits) held on a playing area at the back of the athletics track. Look at the program for times.
- You are reminded that because of increased risk of theft and damage the following are NOT to be brought to the Carnival.
 - Sporting gear – tennis balls, soccer balls, footballs etc
 - ipods, mp3's, trumpets/vuvuzelas etc
 - Water pistols or any other item that is not appropriate for a normal school day.
- Students are reminded that mobile phones should NOT be brought as it is your responsibility and we can not guarantee that the device can be kept secure.

- Make sure you bring a hat, sunscreen and clothing that is sun protective. If it is a cold day bring warm clothing that you can wear over your sports uniform when not competing.
- The Carnival will go ahead even if the weather is uncertain on Wednesday. Check the College website after 7:15am for arrangements if you have any doubts.
- You will not be able to be collected by a parent/carer from the carnival until AFTER the Final Roll Call at the end of the day. Any student who has a doctor's, dentist or some other professional appointment and who will need to leave early on the day MUST see their Year Coordinator by the end of Lunch 2 on Friday 8th June. No student will be allowed to leave the track by making a phone call to their parents on the day.
- The smooth running of the day requires everyone's full cooperation. Our usual expectations concerning conduct and behaviour apply at all times.
- We are responsible for ensuring that the whole field area is left clean and tidy so it will be our final task of the day to pick up every piece of rubbish. It will make it a lot easier if everyone uses the bins throughout the day.
- There will be a Final Roll Call at approximately 2.15pm.
- The usual timetable for after school buses from President Ave will apply for those going back to school.
- The Athletics Carnival allows for greater participation than the swimming carnival so join in, support your House, and enjoy the day.
- An Application For Special Consideration Form is available for any student who is unable to take part in the Athletics Carnival due to illness or other extenuation circumstances. This is only to be used by students who wish to be considered for SSCCC representation and can only be collected, from Mr. Joyce or the College website, before the Carnival.
