Payment Terms and Conditions
Annual accounts are issued in Term one and parents can nominate to pay fees by the term, monthly or fortnightly. Weekly payments are also accepted. Accounts can be paid by Bpay, direct deposit, credit card, cash, cheques, eftpos or Centrepay. It is expected that accounts will be paid by the due date shown on the statement. The College may exclude a student from non compulsory events such as an overseas excursions or graduation where genuine inability to pay in full and on time cannot be substantiated with required documentation.

Explanation of Fees

Archdiocesan Tuition Fee

This fee is determined by the Sydney Archdiocesan Catholic Schools Board. Fees are charged for the first three students attending Catholic systemic school. There is a sibling reduction of 10% for the second child and 35% for the third child. The fee does not apply to fourth and subsequent children from the same family.

Building Levy

This levy is determined by the Sydney Archdiocesan Catholic Schools Board and assists in the repayment of loans for school buildings, repairs and maintenance and building insurance.

Resource Fee

The Resource fee is the amalgamation of the subject fee, elective fee and technology fee, all detailed as follows. *Subject Fee* This fee contributes to the cost of sport, textbooks, workbooks, HSC administration, photocopying, equipment needs and classroom consumables. *Technology Fee* This fee contributes to costs associated with broadband access, licence fees and the management of warranty repairs of laptops. *Elective Fee* Elective courses have specific charges associated with them. Years 9/10 fee allows two elective courses. Years 11/12 covers all elective courses except Open High, TAFE VET and Distance Education. Depending on course selection, elective surcharges may apply.

Elective Surcharge

Due to the practical projects embedded in the curriculum some courses attract a surcharge. In Years 9/10 the courses are Information Software Technology, Industrial Technology, Engineering, Food Technology, Physical Activity and Sports Science.

In Years 11/12 the courses are Information Construction, Industrial Technology, Food Technology, Hospitality Operations and Marine Studies 1 and 2.

Excursion Levy

The non refundable excursion levy and supplementary levy covers incursions/excursions and St Patrick's Day celebrations. Supplementary excursion levies will appear on accounts for the following Year 9/10 electives: Dance, Drama, Music, Physical Activity and Sport Science and Visual Arts.

Years 11-12 Excursions

Excursions for Years 11/12 are charged on a per excursion basis. No refunds are given for non attendance.

Camps

Camps are not part of the excursion levy and are billed separately. No refunds are given for non attendance.

Student Administration Fee

This fee contributes to the cost of newsletters, postage, pastoral care, copyright costs, student ID cards and diaries, stationery, prizes and graduation awards and library.

Maintenance Fee

This family fee contributes to building, grounds and pool maintenance, repairs and minor upgrades.

Fundraising Levy

The fundraising levy is used to upgrade resources and facilities.

Miscellaneous Charges

Laptop hire fee for Year 9 and 12. This fee will be phased out in 2019 with full rollout of BYODD. Additional fees may be charged in Terms 2 or 3, however the College endeavours to keep these to a minimum.
